## AND THE HEALING WILL COME

The bride of Christ today is found sick and crying for her healing, while binding Satan for his role in her sickness. There is something wrong with this picture, my friends. Allow me to explain to you the reason why I say that, for I found myself doing the same thing until God opened my eyes to understand the beauty of His sovereignty in my life. I understand that He deals with each of us differently, but His Word stands with the same message for all of us. Firstly He showed me that I was **chosen** before the foundation of the world. God uses people as in our family- our children, spouse, friends, employer, colleagues and the list goes on and on, including Satan and his demons, to refine and to mold us unto His holiness. In no way shape or form can Satan touch our life, unless God lets him and that with a purpose to bring us to the place where He wants us to be in Christ, reflecting His glory in submission always to His sovereignty in humbleness of heart, repenting and accepting all things in thankfulness to Him that you are His chosen one. You must have faith to believe this truth, even when it will be hard to do so. Then the healing, found in His promise for you, will come. The healing will not come over night, but will take many days and possibly weeks, for it will come as you are submissive to Him, allowing Him to sanctify you through His Word. For that you have to make time to sit still in His presence, willing to hear and learn from His Word.
