I cannot pray, Our Father Who is in heaven until I become a child of God by receiving and believing in His Son, YAHSHUA (John 1:12).

I cannot pray, Hallowed be Your name until I learn to honor His name above all names; until my mouth refrains from taking His name in vain (Exodus 20:7).

I cannot pray, Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is done in heaven, until my will is entwined with God's will to deny self, to take my cross and follow Him, for the establishment of His kingdom in my life (Matt. 16:24).

I cannot pray, Give us today our daily bread until I realize that my sustenance comes from every word that comes from the mouth of God (Matt. 4:4).

I cannot pray, Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors, until my heart is free from bitterness against others; until my heart is humble before YAHWEH and my brothers and sisters, until I let all be free from the bondage of my bitterness against them (Mark 11:25-26).

I cannot pray, Do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one, until I am abiding under His protection, in His shadow; until I remain in Him, and His words remain in me (Psalm 91:1; John 15).
