Rainbow in the Sky – God Spoke (Genesis 9:11-17)

I set My bow (rainbow) in the cloud, and it shall be a token or sign of a covenant or solemn pledge between Me and the earth. And it shall be that when I bring clouds over the earth and the bow (rainbow) is seen in the clouds, I will remember My covenant or solemn pledge which is between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters will no more become a flood to destroy and make all flesh corrupt (Gen. 9:13-15).

The beautiful colors of a rainbow radiate God's faithfulness in His promise not to destroy the entire earth with water again. Every time we see a rainbow circle on the sky the promise of God comes alive. It is as if He was speaking at that moment to us as He did to Noah when He established a covenant with him. The rainbow was the result of judgment God sent to the earth when the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth and that every imagination and intention of all human thinking was only evil continually; and He regretted that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved at heart (Gen. 6:5,6). God's rainbow still shines its colors on the sky reminding us He has not forgotten the covenant He had made with men. However, today's earth continues being polluted. The stench of its pollution has reached heaven and like in the days of Noah, before the judgment when all was corrupted with the exception of him and his family, God is grieving and judgment is at the door to cleanse the evil from this earth. Today when a rainbow is seen in the sky those who practice homosexuality are reminded not of God's promise, but of their immoral life style, which is spreading all over this earth. Today men have the appearance and mannerism of women and women of men. They have polluted the divine message and meaning of the rainbow in its beautiful colors by having adopted its color as the symbol and representation of their immorality. Through them Satan has smudged the colors of God's covenant with men to direct them to his agenda.

In the days before the flood, when men began to multiply and sons of God (fallen angels) had married the daughters of men, they bore ungodly offspring. They were giants and mighty men. The whole earth became wicked, "every imagination and intention of all human thinking was evil continually" bringing the wrath of God upon all mankind. Noah and his family were the only ones found righteous before Him. After God had seen the condition of the earth, how degenerate and vicious it was, how violent and how men had lost their true direction, God had a meeting with Noah to reveal him His plan to destroy the earth and at the same time the plan of salvation for Noah and his family. He said to Noah, For behold, I, even I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth to destroy and make putrid all flesh under the heavens in which are the breath and spirit of life; everything that is on the land shall die; but I will establish My covenant with you, and you shall come into the ark- you and your sons and your wife and your sons' wives with you (Gen. 6:12-18). God also spared two of every animal and fowls and told Noah to collect foods for him and for the animals. Noah did everything God commanded him and at God's timing, He called Noah and the animals by two into the ark seven days before He send the flood upon the earth. Noah was 600 years old when the flood of waters came upon the earth (Gen. 7: 1,4,6,). He and his family and all the animals stayed in the ark until God stop the waters, closed the fountains of the deep and made a wind blow over the land. When it was dry,

Noah got out of the ark and all the animals with him. He built an altar to the Lord and offered Him burnt offerings. They were pleasing to the Lord and He received them.

Then the Lord blessed them and instructed them on rules to live by. At that time He established a covenant with Noah, his family and all the living creatures of the land never to destroy the world with water and a sign was given them: the rainbow. The rainbow was to be a sign to men and a remembrance to God. That colorful covenant has stood in heaven for all those years showing men the faithfulness of God's promise. However, we are living in the days of Noah: days of violence, immorality, wickedness. The judgment of God will be poured on the earth as Peter warned. The present heavens and earth have been stored up for fire, being kept until the Day of Judgment and destruction of the ungodly people (II Peter 3:7). The rainbow in the sky should speak to us of a second judgment coming to earth because men have profaned and mocked God's sign of His covenant and His establishment of family. They are bringing upon themselves the judgment of God as we see in the words of Paul to the Romans: Therefore God gave them up in the lusts of their [own] hearts to sexual impurity, to the dishonoring of their bodies among themselves [abandoning them to the degrading power of sin]. Because they exchanged the truth of God for a lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, Who is blessed forever! Amen. For this reason God gave them over and abandoned them to vile affections and degrading passions. For their women exchanged their natural function for an unnatural and abnormal one, and the men also turned from natural relations with women and were set ablaze with lust for one another – men committing shameful acts with men and suffering in their own bodies and personalities the inevitable consequences and penalty of their wrong doings and going astray, which was fitting retribution, and so, since they did not see fit to acknowledge God or approve of Him or consider Him worth the knowing, God gave them over to a base and condemned mind to do things not proper or decent but loathsome... though they are fully aware of God's righteous decree that those who do such things deserve to die, they not only do them themselves but approve and applaud others who practice them. Therefore you have no excuse or defense or justification (Romans 1:24-28, 32:2:1a).

The rainbow is the voice of God; it is silent, but brilliantly reflects God's words to mankind. After the judgment in Noah's day it spoke never to destroy the earth with water, but because men have changed its meaning to reflect their immoral depravation, it speaks of the coming judgment by fire. In these perilous times men are lovers of self and lovers of sensual pleasures; they will not tolerate sound and wholesome instruction, but having ears itching, they will gather to themselves one teacher after another to a considerable number, chosen to satisfy their own liking and to foster the errors they hold (II Tim. 4:3). The sin of homosexuality is an abomination to God because it is contrary to the purpose for which He created it. It is rebellion against Him. Its actions are contrary to the command of God, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth" (Gen 9:1a). It is a deliberate sin, because men are knowledgeable of it. One of the laws given to the Israelites while they were in the desert was, "You shall not lie with a man as with a woman; it is an abomination; do not defile yourselves in any of these ways, for in all these things the nations are defiled which I am casting out before you; whoever commits any of these abominations shall be cut off from among [his] people (Leviticus 18:22, 24,29). Paul gives

the list of those who will not share the kingdom of God: he says, Do you not know that the unrighteous and the wrongdoers will not inherit of have any share in the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived neither the impure and immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor those who participate in **homosexuality**. This is just a partial list. It continues to several more verses.

My friend read clearly what God is saying to you. YAHSHUA has said, Unless you repent you will all perish in your sins. The sin of homosexual-ism is very serious. It is a sin that brings the wrath of God. All nations that have made this practice legal are under the wrath of God. Remember Sodom and Gomorra. The rainbow's colors are not to be considered a symbol of immorality, but a symbol of God's faithfulness. He is the Creator of all those colors; He established them for His own purpose. Men are to respect and hear God's voice through the rainbow. He still speaks today!
