

THE WORD OF GOD

The Law of the Lord is perfect- restoring the soul
The testimony of the Lord is sure- making wise the simple
The precepts of the Lord are right- rejoicing the heart
The commandments of the Lord are pure – enlightening the eyes
The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever;
The ordinances of the Lord are true and righteous altogether
They are to be desired more than gold; sweeter than honey
By them your servant is warned;

The Word of the God is our Savior and Lord YAHSHUA. John declared saying, In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God Himself (John 1:1). When He created the world, all He did was to call forth the world into existence and there it happened. It was through the power of His word that the world was created. The heavens stand up high declaring the glory of God through the firmament with twinkling stars, YAHSHUA'S handiwork. Their twinkles call our attention to the beauty and wisdom of our Creator. They are alive, proclaiming without speech, the knowledge of God. Silently, their voices echo throughout the entire world the beauty displayed in the dark of the night for all to see. *"God commands the sun, and it rises not; He seals up the stars [from view]; Who alone stretches out the waves and high places of the sea; Who made [the constellations] the Bear, Orion, and the [loose cluster] Pleiades, and the [vast starry] spaces of the south; Who does great things past finding out, yes marvelous things without number (Job 9:7-10). God made the Pleiades and Orion, Who turns the shadow of death or deep darkness into the morning and darkens the day onto night. Who calls for waters of the sea and pours them out upon the face of the earth- he LORD (ADONAI) is His name (Amos 5:8b). The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows and proclaims His handiwork (Ps. 19:1).*

*The written word of God is alive and powerful; it is sharper than any two-edge sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life and spirit, and of joints and marrow, exposing and sifting and analyzing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart (Heb. 4:12). More precious than anything in this world, the Word of God is to be desired above gold and silver and all the riches of this world. The Word of God manifests itself in many ways; men are without excuse before the living God. Paul warns us, *For that which is known about God is evident to them and made plain in their inner consciousness, because God has shown it to them. For ever since the creation of the world His invisible nature and attributes, that is. His eternal power and divinity, have been made intelligible and clearly discernible in and through the things that have been made. So, [men] are without excuse. Because when they knew and recognized Him as God, they did not honor and glorify Him as God or give Him thanks. But instead, they became futile and godless in their thinking and their senseless minds were**

darkened (Rom. 1:19-21). Love of money is the root of all evil (I Tim.6:10). It is replacing God, in your life, for the god mammon- wealth or money. In Luke 16, YAHSHUA gives a parable of illustration of a rich man, who clothed himself in purple and made merry in splendor every day. Meanwhile, at his gate there was an utterly destitute man named Lazarus covered with sores, feeding himself from the crumbs that fell from the rich man's table. The greedy heart of the rich man, selfishly ignored the poor man until the day came when they both passed away. The future that waited the rich man was a place of torment. Not because he was rich, but for his greedy way of life; the love of money, profited nothing for his eternal life, but anguish in the flame. YAHSHUA asked the question, what does it profit a man to gain the world and forfeit his soul? (Mark 8:36).

The earth is filled with the wisdom of our God. It is the Word of God – YAHSHUA in beautiful colors. The flowers of the fields, the stars in the sky, the ocean and its power all point to the Creator YAHSHUA, the Word of God, as well as the melodious sounds coming from birds of all kind, as in the mocking bird! In awesomeness they filled the air praising their Creator. Yes, the world was created in order and in perfect harmony, uniting all in one accord. Psalm 19 starts with the declaration; *The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows and proclaims His handiwork. Day after day pours forth speech, and night after night shows forth knowledge; there is no speech nor spoken word [from the stars]; their voice is not heard. Yet, their voice goes out through all the earth, their sayings to the end of the world, Of the heavens has God made a tent for the sun, which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber; and it rejoices as a strong man to run his course; its going forth is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the ends of it; and nothing is hidden from the heat of it. (Ps. 19:1-6).*

The Word of God does not say, the world was created out of a big boom, chaotically, it was formed without understanding and wisdom. No one knows how it happened, but here it is after million years, it kept evolving from one thing to another, as animals, to humans. This way, our forefathers were monkeys which came from a fish. Men removed God from the equation of creation, when they foolishly created their own, confusing idea of how the world was created. To this day, they profess this lie, while nature continuously, day and night, stands firmly declaring the truth: In the beginning, God....

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The book of Genesis details how He did it. *But when He created man, He said, Let Us [Father, Son and Holy Spirit] make mankind in Our image, after Our likeness, and let them have complete authority over the fish of the sea, the birds of the air, the beasts and over all of the earth, and over everything that creeps upon the earth. So, created man in His own image, in the image and likeness of God, He created him; male and female He created them (Gen. 1:1,26-27).*

Look around you and be in awe of God's creation. Men cannot fathom the depth of His wisdom. Paul declares: *Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unfathomable are His judgments! And how untraceable are His ways! For who has known the mind of the Lord and who has understood His thoughts, or who has been His counselor?... For from Him and through Him are all things. To Him be glory forever! Amen (Rom.11:33-34,36). YAHSHUA is the sole expression of the glory of God and He is the perfect imprint and very image*

of [God's] nature, upholding and maintaining and guiding and propelling the universe by His mighty word of power... (Heb. 1:3).

God's world is not a result of a boom; It is rather orderly, and it is upheld by the Creator Himself. Remember that "it is because of the Lord's mercy and loving-kindness that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not; they are new every morning, great and abundant is His faithfulness" (Lam. 3:22-23). It is because He stands controlling the order of the universe that we are not destroyed. That proves that this world was not created from a "boom." Imagine the chaos it would have been if so! The Word of God is Love expressed in every way from the beginning of creation; we see it through what He created. Beauty everywhere in the skies, on the earth. My friend, embrace the written Word of God and come to know Who He is in an intimate way. Develop a relationship with Him and His Word and you will be blessed.
